Our Sacrifice

"Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy **sacrifice**, acceptable to God, *which is* your spiritual service of worship." (Rom. 12:1)

Our Sacrifice

"Through Him then, let us continually offer up a **sacrifice** of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that give thanks to His name." (Heb. 13:15)

Our Sacrifice

"And do not neglect doing good and sharing, for with such **sacrifices** God is pleased." (Heb. 13:15-16)

Our Sacrifice

"But I have received everything in full and have an abundance; I am amply supplied, having received from Epaphroditus what you have sent, a fragrant aroma, an acceptable **sacrifice**, well-pleasing to God." (Phil. 4:18)

Our Sacrifice

"¹⁵But I have written very boldly to you on some points so as to remind you again, because of the grace that was given me from God, ¹⁶to be a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles, ministering as a priest the gospel of God, so that *my offering* of the Gentiles may become acceptable, sanctified by the Holy Spirit."
(Rom. 15:15-16)
