### *Jesus' Prediction*

<sup>20</sup>Remember the word that I said to you, 'A slave is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you; if they kept My word, they will keep yours also. <sup>21</sup>But all these things they will do to you for **My name's sake**, because they do not know the One who sent Me." (Jn. 15:20-21)
